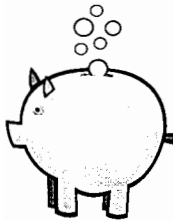

Camper Bank

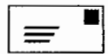
All money campers bring are expected to be deposited in the Camper Bank. Spending money must be cash. Campers may with-

draw up to \$4 per day (\$5 for teens). Additional monies may be withdrawn for purchases at the Gift Shop. Please encourage campers not to hide money in their cabin. Camp Spofford cannot be responsible for any stolen money.

Camper Health Forms

Campers may not attend Camp without completed health forms. This requires a physical within two years prior to attending Camp and a current health record. It must be signed by both the doctor and the parent.

No exceptions to this rule!!

All prescription drugs (except inhalers) will be held by the nurse for safety reasons. Campers arrange with the nurse to take their prescriptions.

An express line is provided for those paid in advance.

Pick up time is 9:00 am Saturday

Early arrivals and stay-overs

are charged a \$35 fee for Saturday night. Please call the office if this is not on your bill. You will also need extra spending money for the second week.

Camp Spofford is a "closed" Camp. No camper may leave Camp grounds unless accompanied by Camp personnel.
